Instructions for Submitting Abstracts

- **TEMPLATE:** Use the [WHEC 2012 Abstract Template](#) to create your abstract, completing information in the boxes highlighted in yellow.
- **TITLE:** Use upper case on first word, after a colon and on any proper nouns (Sentence case).
- **AUTHORS:** The submitting and presenting authors must be shown on your abstract. Note that you will be asked to complete full information on all authors in the online form when uploading your abstract, including name, affiliation, city and country.
- **ABSTRACT:** The following guidelines must be respected for structure and formatting of your abstract:
 - o **Contents:** Background, Design, Results, Conclusion
 - o **Font:** Times New Roman (12pt), including any special characters and embedded equations.
 - o **Text:** Do not indent or justify paragraphs. Tables, figures and graphics are permitted. Total number of **words must not exceed 200**.
 - o **Format:** Abstracts may be uploaded in Microsoft Word, which will be converted automatically to PDF, or as native PDF format.
 - o **Corrections:** Abstract files should be reviewed carefully before submission. To correct and replace an abstract after submission, the author must log in to his account. This will only be possible until the closure of the online submission form at the end of the call for abstracts.
- **REFERENCES:** References may be included (maximum: 50 words), and should be cited [1] in the separate 'References' field (see [template](#)) as shown in footnote below:
[1] A.N. Author, Journal Name, Vol., 123-456, (Year)
- **VERIFICATION:** Review and save your abstract on your desktop. NOTE: Abstracts must not be longer than 200 words.
- **SUBMISSION:** Go to the [online form](#), where you will be prompted to create an account, complete abstract details, and upload your saved abstract.
